



TAB YOUNG PROFESSIONAL LEADERSHIP GRANT

The ARMA Canada Region provides Leadership training to in-coming or current ARMA Canada Chapter Leaders. Leadership participants receive professional and personal development during Leadership training, while obtaining knowledge required for managing a Chapter. Past Leadership training topics include: project management, personality types and conflict resolution.

The 2011 Leadership Training will be held June 4-5, 2011 in Charlottetown, PEI.

Purpose

The TAB Young Professional Leadership Grant is intended to provide Young Professionals, who do not have the opportunity to attend Leadership training because they are not Chapter Board members for a Canadian Chapter.

Financial Support

TAB will sponsor up to \$1,200 for up to 5 Young Professionals from any ARMA Canada Chapter to attend Leadership Training.

Financial Support will cover flights & transportation, 2 nights accommodation and any meals that are not provided during leadership training

Eligibility & Selection

1. Applicants must be:
 - A Canadian ARMA member in good standing;
 - A young professional. ARMA Canada has defined a Young Professional being 35 years of age or younger or new to the profession (within 5 years).
 - Have an interest in contributing or pursuing excellence within ARMA and/or the RIM profession.
2. Young Professionals should submit an application letter indicating how they will benefit from attending the Leadership training. The application letter should accompany a letter of support from either their Region Coordinators and/or Chapter President.
3. Application deadline: April 1, 2011
